Homeless Health Care Los Angeles Receives \$50,000 Grant from the Foxwynd Foundation to Support Healthy Meals in Skid Row

Los Angeles, CA – January 29, 2026 – Homeless Health Care Los Angeles (HHCLA) is proud to announce a generous \$50,000 grant from the Foxwynd Foundation to support the organization’s efforts to provide nutritious, healthy meals to unhoused individuals living in the downtown area of Los Angeles known as Skid Row Skid Row. The grant is distributed through a Donor Advised Fund (DAF) managed by the Foxwynd Foundation.
